“God Is All-Powerful”



When you think of POWER, what images come to mind?
What examples were given in the weekend message?

What does it mean when Ps. 62:11 says that power belongs to the Lord?

What if God did not have the power? What would that mean for us?

Good News! We are learning what God is like, and He is All-Powerful.

#1. The world presents us with some great, great challenges

What are some of the most difficult challenges you have faced in your life?
What is something that you are dealing with right now that is very hard?

Read Jer. 32:1-8

What were the 2 problems that Jeremiah was facing?
Which of those would have been harder for you to deal with?
Why?

Do you have anything in your life similar to Jeremiah's 2 struggles?
How does that feel for you?

In the midst of Jeremiah's struggle, he remembered something important.
God is All-Powerful, and nothing is too difficult for Him.

#2. Nothing is too difficult for the Lord

Power can be thought of as:

- Sheer force & strength
- Ability

God has sheer force & strength.

Read Ps. 18:13-15

What kind of image of God do those verses represent?
Does that bother you? Why or why not?

God also has ability. He is not just big, but He is able.

When we say, God is able, what does that say to you?

How does that speak to your heart?

What if we had to say the opposite, "God is not able."

How would that feel? What would that mean?

How has God shown that He is able?

-He has the power to CREATE (Gen. 1)

Think about what it means that God created everything.

What does that say about God and His power?

-He has the power to KEEP

Read. Heb. 1:3. God upholds everything by the word of His power. Wow.

How powerful is God, that He is upholding everything in the universe by His Word.

Read. John 10:27-30. God upholds you and your salvation.

How comforting is it that nothing or no one can take you out of God's hand?

-He has the power to CONTAIN

Do we realize how much evil God holds back every day?

What if God were to remove His hand from the United States of America/this world?

-He has power OVER EVERYTHING

Read Dan. 4:35.

How powerful are the host/armies of heaven?

How powerful are the power players here on this earth?

What difference does it make that God is over all of those?

#3. So we can trust Him with our lives

Read Jer. 32:42-44.

God promised that men would buy fields and make deals again in the land of Judah and that He would restore them. That means that God can do anything. Even take a defeated nation and bring it back together again.

How badly do we need God in our nation?

Do you ever feel like it is hopeless or has gotten past the point of no return?

Do you believe that God can turn our country around?

How would He do that?

How would He want you to be a part of that?

If God can do that, shouldn't we trust Him to do anything?

What is it right now in your own life that you are struggling to trust God for?

If God is All-Powerful, what does that mean for your struggle?

Will you trust Him?

How can we pray for each other today?
